- Financial assistance and charity care is available for those who qualify.

- Basic hospice services are enhanced with massage therapy, music therapy, music-thanatology and Jewish Care Services.
- Hundreds of individuals learn about hospice, palliative care and advance directives each year through community presentations and in-services.
- Healthcare professionals can participate in educational programs: fellowship in palliative medicine, short-term clinical learning opportunities, seminars or conferences.
- Through *Caring Kids in Action*, children and teens participate in a variety of activities that include and/or benefit seniors and disabled individuals.
- Community groups can use space in our central facility for meetings, whether large or small.
