- **Grief Support**—Individual and group counseling for adults and children who have lost loved ones.
- **Other supportive services** for hospice patients, such as Jewish Care Services and Music Care Services.

Our goal is to ensure that you and your family receive medical and supportive care that improves your quality of life ... wherever you live ... whatever your age.

## What about payment?

Medicare, Medicaid and most private insurance companies cover hospice services and palliative care consultations.

If your insurance doesn't completely cover your care, we will work with you to determine reimbursement options or to develop a payment plan if necessary.

We offer charity care and financial assistance for patients who qualify.

Grief support services are offered at no charge to members of the community.

- Is medical care that is provided by an interdisciplinary team to improve your quality of life and relieve suffering.
- Addresses physical symptoms as well as your emotional, interpersonal and spiritual concerns.
